# What The

- FM2Play worked fine yesterday and now it attempts to play exes
  - I haven't touch anything in the last year that had anything to do with this
  - At least I can't see anything that should effect it

# I built all the change sets since FM2Play was added

- They all try to play exes and text files and ...
- What am I missing
- What else did I change

# Remember The F1 Failure with PMSeek

- Nobody changed PMSeek
- Nobody even had the source
- How could this happen
- Then it became obvious it happen on all utility programs that were dialog boxes instead of frames

# Who's Help Hook is this Anyway

- I had installed a Rexx Xcenter Plugin
  - Who knew
- I uninstalled the Rexx plugin and nothing changed
  - Would have been helpful if I knew that Xcenter plugins get loaded if they are in the plugin directory even if they aren't installed

# This Makes Me Nuts

- I then started to believe it was Xcenter not the Rexx plugin
  - If I closed Xcenter the problem went away
- Then I tried it on my maintenance partition
  - Xcenter and no Rexx plugin and guess what
  - Finally I asked if the DLLs get loaded
    - Of course they do

# Smoking Gun Sorta

- I knew what did it but had know idea why
- What I knew about Xcenter plugins could be placed in a thimble with plenty of room left for a finger
- But what is a global help hook and why is it in this Rexx plugin

# Remove the Hook

- Dumb luck is always better than skill
- I removed the hook
  - The bad behavior in PMSeek and its relatives when away
  - The Rexx plugin help still worked
  - Go figure



# What Does Any of This Have to Do with FM2Play?

- Since I wrote the code to include FM2Play in FM2 the obvious problem was the nut behind the keyboard
- So why does it work on a fresh install of eCS?
  - Licensing?
- MMIOMP3 isn't installed

# MMIOMP3?

- I finally look at the code; the LIB used in the original was rigidly tied to the standard which is routinely violated
  - Using the MMOS2 check code would have resulted in most MP3s not playing
  - Solution say you can play anything

# Mommy Make It Stop

- Fortunately the latest madlib (appropriately named) has a relaxed ID protocol
- I simply reinstated the check and all works
- I have it with me if you would like a copy
- I have been in communication with Alex Taylor about updating the package on Hobbes
  - It will happen soon

# It Isn't Possible That There Are More

- Enter lSwitcher
  - Programs should be restored to the desktop they were minimized on.
    - Sounds reasonable
  - Pager sticky windows shouldn't work anyway
  - It's a lot more fun when programs get sent to never never land
    - Program location coordinates that are negative is creative but not a great idea

# ISwitcher

- OK I will fix it (actual already have)
- I'm keeping the code just in case
  - Remember Object Desktop
    - It restarted apps on the virtual desktop you wanted it on
    - How did they do that?
- Is it also what forces me to restart the desktop to avoid icon loss?
  - Probably should actually test this

# How Does This Work

- The OS2 Desktop is huge (at least 32k by 32k)
  - This is what makes virtual Desktops possible
- Ever wonder why on shut down you switch to the base window and all the running apps follow?
- lswitcher tried to restore minimized programs to their virtual desktop of origin instead of the current desktop using the absolute coordinates
  - It works sometimes

# Sticky Windows?

- Uses the fact that minimized windows are restored to the current desktop in the same relative position as where they are minimized
  - Now ISwitcher has changed this
  - Sticky windows not only don't work they can't work
- Obvious work around identify sticky windows and bypass the code that returns them to their original desktop

# Problem

- There is no public interface to query to find out if a window is sticky or not.
- Need to fix this in Xworkplace
- Need to add conditional code to maintain backward compatibility



# Moral of the Story

- If something suddenly brakes immediately figure out what you changed
- Waiting until you have made 25 changes is not the way to fix these
- Always suspect other software!
  - It can't possibly be me
